The winner will have a chance to study fashion in our School for free during the first year of two and a half year program.

THE ORGANISER: Cracow School of Art and Fashion Design

THEME: TRANQUILITY and OPTIMISM.

To take part in the competition you have to prepare a collection of 3 silhouettes.

DEADLINE: The deadline for all application materials is **20 May, 2016**.

ENTRY: There is no entry fee and no age limits.

RULES & REGULATIONS:

The application materials should be completed as listed below:

- 1 illustration for each silhouette;
- 1 page for the fabric and material swatches;
- 1 page for the mood board;
- 1 page for the written concept in English with a title (maximum 100 words)
- 1 resume / CV of the applicant
- printed and signed application form.

Format of each page: 8.5" x 11" or A4 / and on separate pages (no binding or mounting or else)

JURY:

All projects will be judged by experts and professional fashion designers. The decisions of the board are final. All matters will be decided by majority vote and are not subject to appeal. In case of a tie, the Head of Jury, will cast the deciding vote.
